We will be collecting: library books, sports uniforms, textbooks, etc. <u>Please note: 6th and 7th grade students will not be returning Chromebooks at this time unless you are moving out of district. 8th grade students will return their chrome books unless they plan on attending summer school and in that case will keep them.</u>

# Materials Pick Up (Stop #3) (District Office Entrance)

A staff member will place a bag(s) next to your vehicle. Please retrieve the bag and give a nice social distance wave.

### Walking up to school

Please note that in order for this process to run smoothly, we ask that all vehicles and walk-ups enter Spring Wood campus from the correct entry driveway (Main Entrance).
